- * 1 large canister of **Clorox** disinfecting wipes
- * 1 pack of **Ticonderoga** #2 pencils (12-pack) (not fat primary)
- * 1 box of Cap Erasers
- * 4 packs of 8-count **Crayola** crayons (**regular size**, not fat) (classic colors only)
- * 1 pack of **Crayola** washable markers (classic colors only)
- * 1 pack of 12 count **Crayola** color pencils
- * 1 plastic pencil box - clearly labeled with name
