RACE DETAILS

Directions to the Matteson Trail:

From 1-64 West: Take Exit 262 - Magruder Blvd. Go through two lights, and at the third light, turn left onto Butler Farm Road. Turn right at the first driveway.

From 1-64 East: Take Exit 261-B - Hampton Roads Center Pkwy. From the Parkway, take the Magruder Blvd. Exit and bear left on the ramp, and then turn left onto Magruder Blvd. Turn left at the first traffic light you come to at Butler Farm Road. Turn Right at the first driveway.

About the Course: The Matteson Trail is located at the Hampton's Golf Course and encircles the course. The 3-mile nature/fitness trail is named in honor of Tess Matteson, a member of the Hampton Roads Bird Club who was instrumental in the development of the trail. The trail is open from 7 a.m. until sunset and walking in pairs is encouraged. As you enjoy this picturesque trail, watch out for stray balls from the golf course.
